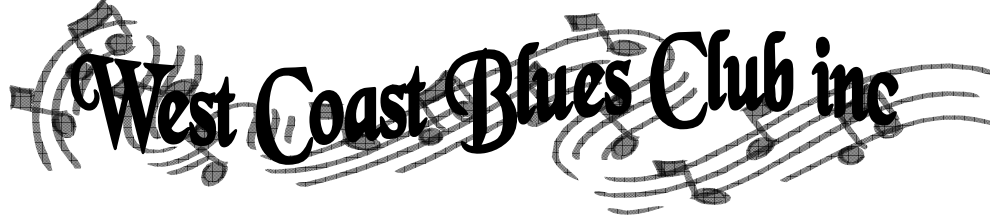

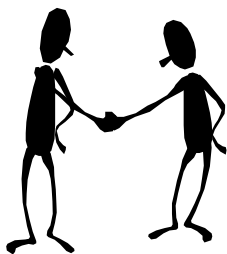

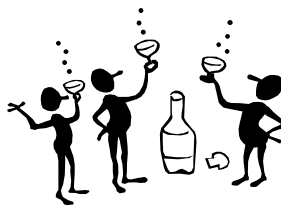

SPREAD THE WORD!

LLOYD SPIEGEL is a singer, songwriter and guitarist with a reputation for excellence in his music and performance. At just 25 years of age, Lloyd has 15 years experience in the music business and is regarded as one of Australia's finest blues performers.

After winning his first talent competition at age 10, he soon began playing regular gigs in Melbourne and at age 13 he formed blues/rock act, Midnight Special. At 14 he recorded and produced his first CD.

As front man for Midnight Special from 1993 to 1998 and as a solo performer since 1996, Lloyd has played in Melbourne's most popular live venues including the Esplanade Hotel, The Palace, The HI-FI bar and The Continental Cafe as well as the internationally renowned Melbourne Concert Hall where he headlined 2 sellout shows. He has played on bills with many of Australia's biggest names - Billy Thorpe, Jimmy Barnes, The Waifs and John Butler.

Since age 16, Lloyd has toured the U.S.A 6 times where he has become a highly sought after musician for Blues festivals and venues across the country and a favourite of the discerning American blues audiences. During these tours he appeared on bills with legendary Blues artists like Ray Charles, Buddy Guy, Canned Heat and Robert Cray as well as artists from other musical styles like Ani Di Franco, Willie Nelson and Bob Dylan.

As Lloyd's reputation as an energetic & talented performer has spread, he is now playing to packed houses in America, receiving standing ovations and regularly selling out of CDs.

While fans and critics have always focused on his guitar skills, Lloyd has come of age as a composer and lyricist. His most recent album, Tall Stories, sees Lloyd re-invent himself as an artist - it was quickly recognized as a breakthrough recording for him and proves him to be an integral part of Australia's ever-changing blues music style.

Lloyd Spiegel is taking blues and soul music to the next level with the rare combination of youthful energy and experience well beyond his years. With an incredible command of his guitar and powerful vocals, Lloyd's high energy performance and on-stage presence captivates any audience.

How To Sing the Blues

1. Most Blues begin "woke up this morning."
2. "I got a good woman" is a bad way to begin the Blues, unless you stick something nasty in right away: I got a good woman - with the meanest face in town.
3. Blues are simple. After you have the first line right, repeat it. Then find something that rhymes. Sort of. I got a good woman - with the meanest face in town. I got a good woman - with the meanest face in town. She got teeth like Margaret Thatcher and she weighs 500 pounds.
4. The Blues are not about limitless choice. You stuck in a ditch, you stuck in a ditch; ain't no way out.
5. Blues cars are Chevies, Cadillac's and broken-down trucks. Other acceptable Blues transportation modes include Greyhound buses and southbound trains. Walkin' plays a major part in the Blues lifestyle. So does fixin' to die. Blues don't travel in Volvos, BMWs, or SUVs. Jet aircraft and state-sponsored motor pools ain't even in the running.
6. Adults sing the Blues. Teenagers can't sing the Blues. They ain't fixin' to die yet. In the Blues, "adulthood" means old enough to get the electric chair when you shoot that man in Memphis.
7. You can have the Blues in New York City, but not in Brooklyn or Queens. Hard times in Vermont, Tucson, or North Dakota are just depression. The best places to have the Blues are still Chicago, St. Louis, and Kansas City. You cannot have the blues in any place that don't get rain.
8. A man with male pattern baldness ain't the blues. A woman with male pattern baldness is. Breaking your leg while skiing is not the blues. Breaking your leg when your broken-down pickup truck rolled over on it is.
9. The following colours do not belong in the Blues: violet, beige, mauve (unless you're truly desperate for a rhyme).
10. You can't have the Blues in an office or a shopping mall. The lighting is just plain wrong. Go outside to the parking lot or sit by the dumpster.
11. Good places to have the Blues: the highway, a jailhouse, an empty bed, the bottom of a whiskey glass. Bad places to have the Blues: ashrams, gallery openings, weekends in the Hampton's, golf courses, Tiffany's, and Ivy League institutions.
12. No one will believe it's the Blues if you wear a suit, unless you happen to be an old black man - and it's an old black suit.

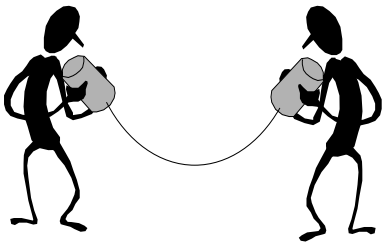

Blues at Bridgetown is the South West's premier music festival, last year attracting around 16,000 people and a sell out for the first time ever.

2006 promises to deliver a smorgasbord of superb musical talent and performance workshops, supported by a free Street Party on Saturday with performing artists scattered along the main street, local youth performers, arts and crafts, food and community stalls.

Our line-up for 2006 is still being finalised, however it promises to be the best ever, with many of

Australia's finest blues and roots performers and one or two surprises from overseas already indicating their interest in appearing. It's early days yet, but we're already in negotiations with, and hope to bring you, artists of the calibre of:

Finis Tasby (USA), The Australian Blues Brothers Show, Kelly Auty "Wild Women" Show, Juzzie Smith, Dallas Frasca, Hat Fitz, The Others, The Audrey's, Jan Preston, The Flood, Nathan Gaunt, Blue Shaddy, Dave Mann Collective, Andrew Winton, Kill Devil Hills...and many more

Artists appearing in 2006 are subject to confirmation, so keep visiting our website to discover who we have signed up!

As in previous years, the festival will take place in five venues, all within the Bridgetown townsite.

- **Alfresco Showcase** - A concert venue by day, the licensed Festival Club becomes a Blues Club at night.
- **Repertory Club** - An intimate, theatre style venue with daytime workshops and semi acoustic performances at night.
- **Blue Owls Nest** - A large, silk lined marquee with shaded outside grassed areas. This year we're planning to provide additional hillside seating for the many fans wishing to catch the headline acts who perform in this licensed venue.
- **Geegelup Brook Marquee** - The perfect place for those who want to get up and dance! This large venue in the centre of town is fully licensed.
- **Plus** - A licensed venue outdoors in the centre of town, with FREE performances on Friday evening, Saturday daytime and evening.

Accommodation in Bridgetown and surrounding areas is limited. Telephone the Bridgetown Visitor Centre on (08) 9761 1740 or visit www.bridgetown.com.au for accommodation information. During the Festival weekend additional camping accommodation is provided at the following three locations.

TENT CITY

Available only to Weekend Ticket holders. Located at the Bridgetown High School Oval. Prices are for 3 nights, 2 days and include tent, beds (not bedding), shower facilities and breakfasts on both days. Power is not provided - bring a torch. No open fires or cooking permitted **\$170 per person, minimum 2 person occupancy (accommodation only and does not include weekend ticket cost).**

VILLAGE CAMPING

\$70 per person, minimum 2 person occupancy (accommodation only and does not include Weekend ticket cost). Available only to Weekend Ticket holders, minimum 2 nights, pre-booked only. In town at St Brigid's School Oval. Family style with children 12 & under free. Bring own tent, camping gear & torch (power not provided). Toilets and children's playground on site, prices include tokens for shower facilities at nearby Bridgetown Swimming Pool. Cooked breakfast available at extra cost (please advise if breakfasts required when booking). **3 nights; \$70 per person. 2 nights; \$50 per person (accommodation only and does not include Weekend ticket cost).**

BUDGET CAMPING

At Bridgetown Showgrounds. Basic facilities only, including showers, toilets & disabled toilet. Bring own tent, sleeping gear and torch. Live music performances during breakfast. No open fires permitted. A limited number of powered sites are available, apply at the Bridgetown Visitor Centre. **From Noon Friday; \$35 per person. From Saturday: \$25 per person. Children under 13: free.**
